REC Plus Program

Kings Soccer Club is excited to announce it is continuing the REC Plus Program in 2012. We will be forming REC Plus Teams for boys and girls in Wings(U-10) and Strickers(U-12) age groups.

The idea of REC Plus is great. With this program we pool our more competitive/skilled players from all of our regular Rec teams and form one team for each age group. We will provide each of our REC Plus teams with additional training and then play them against other SAY REC Plus teams in the area to provide a more competitive experience for the players. A big advantage of this is that your child will be getting an experience similar to a select club without the large financial and time commitments.

Program Summary

-REC Plus teams will play 5-8 games during the season. Games are played on Sundays and will not conflict with the regular Rec games. In the Fall 2011 season we had a Girls Wings(U-10) team that went 6-0-2. We played teams from Loveland, GSSA(Greater Sycamore Soccer Assoc.), West Chester, and Lakota. We also had a scrimmage against two Cincinnati United teams which we hope to continue.

-REC Plus Teams will have practice once a week with a Paid Trainer. In the fall we used a trainer from Cincinnati United for our training sessions and a Licensed Coach for games. The REC Plus players will be required to make the one training session each week with the trainer and one practice on their Rec team. So this will result in them having a total of 2 practices a week and 2 games on most weekends.

-All normal SAY rules apply and each player should play a minimum of 2 periods per game.

-The fee is still being determined but the estimate would be \$50-\$80 dollars. This fee would cover the expenses of jerseys, ref fees, trainers, and a possible tournament.

-Payment would be collected after teams have been formed and finalized
